While the national business magazines may pitch the attitude that failure can result in eventual growth and success, James Sabry, Co-founder and Chairman of the Board of Cytokinetics, tells entrepreneurs venturing out of academia for the first time that failure is not an option. Without that assurance, they will be hard-pressed to find the support they need to launch. Look at the data and approach it scientifically.
